 ETech Dreams, based at Dehradun has come forward to fund the Student Startup Project 'Syncit' as a Technology Partner to develop the prototype app which is first project initiated by NISP.

- Annual 'Innovation & Entrepreneurship Award 'to recognize outstanding ideas, successful enterprises and contributors for promoting innovation and enterprises ecosystem within the Institute.
- Nurturing Innovations and Stratups:
 - Students will not be required to undergo Internship or Organization Study in other organizations if they are working on the startups.
 - Students will be allowed to sit for the examination if their attendance is less than the minimum permissible percentage with due permission from college.
 - Students can take a semester/year break to work on their startups and rejoin the academics to complete the course, depending upon the decision of review committee constituted by the college.
 - Institution may allow faculty/staff to take off for a semester/year as sabbatical/unpaid leave/earned leave for working on a startup and come back.
 - Student will be given option to use Institutes address as startup address, post approval of their startup.

The members were happy with the NISP initiation and suggested to take Mentoring support from established agencies/firms.
